Revised Section 1500.22(j) – redlined version

(j) **Credit for Performing Pro Bono Legal Services.** Credit may be earned for performing uncompensated legal services for clients unable to afford counsel pursuant to (a) assignment by a court; or (b) a program, accredited by the CLE Board, of a bar association, legal services provider or other entity. Credit shall be awarded pursuant to the Regulations and Guidelines of the CLE Board, provided that no more than ~~six ten (10)~~ ten (10) hours of CLE credit may be ~~awarded~~ earned in a two-year reporting period for performing pro bono legal services; ~~and no more than one credit hour of CLE credit may be awarded for every six hours of legal work performed.~~ An additional five (5) hours of CLE credit may be earned subject to the requirements and limitations set forth in the Regulations and Guidelines of the CLE Board.
