

Sources: NYSDMV Driver License file and TSLED ticket system. The TSLED data prior to mid-2009 do not capture tickets issued by NYPD or Suffolk County PD (5 western towns). Since mid-2009, Suffolk County PD tickets are being included in TSLED. As of 2014, all Suffolk County tickets are issued under TSLED. Data were compiled by the ITSMR.
