

Computation of New York CLE Faculty Credit

Speaker: 3 credits for each 50 minutes of presentation

Panelist: 3 credits for each 50 minutes of panel presentation

Moderator: 1 credit for each 50 minutes of moderating a presentation

No additional credit for preparation time

Length of Presentation in minutes (including Q&A session)	Credit for Speaker or Panelist	Credit for Moderator

Repeat presentations within faculty member's biennial CLE reporting cycle

Speaker: 1 credit for each 50 minutes of repeat presentation

Panelist: 1 credit for each 50 minutes of repeat panel presentation

Moderator: No credit for moderating repeat presentation

Computation of faculty credit for programs with multiple speakers

If there are multiple speakers *and* all speakers are in attendance throughout the entire program (including the time during which they are not presenting), then calculate speaker credit for the length of a speaker's presentation and attendance credit for the time that he or she listened to the other presenter(s).

- The length of a Q&A session at the end of a program may be added to the length of each speaker's presentation

Agenda: 9:00 - 9:20 Speaker A
9:20 - 9:40 Speaker B
9:40 - 10:00 Speaker C
10:00 - 10:10 Q&A

Each speaker earns 1.5 speaker credits (20 minutes plus 10 minutes Q&A)
Each speaker also earns .5 attendance credits (40 minutes listening)

- Where a speaker earns both speaker and attendance credit, be sure to enter the credit in the correct area on the Certificate of Attendance.

E. Credit for Attendance

Award credit in accordance with §8(A)(4)(a) of the Regulations. Enter number of credits earned in each category:

For Newly Admitted and/or Experienced Attorneys:

For Experienced Attorneys Only:
