- The courthouse opens daily to the public at **8:00am**
 - Court convenes at **9:30am** sharp
 - Lunch is from **1pm – 2:15pm**
 - Seating is on a first come first served basis
 - There will be reserved seating for members of the media
 - Only one member of an organization may be in the courtroom at a time
 - Quiet Laptops are allowed for note taking
 - Any other electronic devices, phones, audio recorders etc. are **not** allowed and must be turned off
 - **No** texting, tweeting, emailing or any outside communication will be allowed from the courtroom
 - When court is in session, you may briefly leave and return by notifying the Court Officer at the door
 - **During Lunch:** Members of the media may use the Central Jury Room on the 15th Floor and the hallway on the 13th floor to work and recharge laptops.
 - There will not be an overflow room
- **Any breach of these rules in the courtroom, will subject the violator and his/her outlet to ejection from the courtroom for the duration of the trial, possible contempt citation by the judge, and may result in an arrest.**
