

**Application for Press Credentials**  
**People of the State of New York v Harvey Weinstein**  
**02673-2019**  
**New York State Supreme Court – Criminal Term**  
**Part 99**

**Eligibility:**

To be eligible to receive a temporary press credential, an applicant must be a member of the media who will be covering, in person, either for the duration, or on a day-by-day basis, the trial of the People of the State of New York v Harvey Weinstein – indictment 02673-2019 in Part 99 of New York State Supreme Court – Criminal Term.

- Applicants must submit a copy of a valid U.S. Government issued photo ID along with a letter, on letterhead, from the organization where the coverage will appear.
- ★ Freelance reporters must have the accredited news organization or agency affirmatively ensure that they are employing the applicant to cover the trial. ★
- The letter along with a legible copy of the valid ID may be scanned and emailed to [publicinformation@nycourts.gov](mailto:publicinformation@nycourts.gov)
- Members of the media who already possess a valid NYPD Working Press Card with their photo on it, **not** a reserve/pool card, or a New York State Unified Court System SECURE Pass, **do not** need to apply for this card.
- Use of laptops, tablets, iPads, iPhones, inside the courtroom during the trial, is at the sole discretion of the presiding judge.

**To maintain safety, security and order throughout the court facility for Judges, court employees, jurors, litigants and visitors:**

Media access including still photography, video or audio recording in any public area of the courthouse, including the areas adjacent to Part 99, are at the sole discretion of New York State Court Officers.

Media access including still photography, video or audio recording inside the courtroom is at the sole discretion of the presiding judge.
