Said examinations are to be held at a place and time mutually convenient to the parties on

and shall continue on a **day-to-day** basis until completed.

The parties shall notify the Court upon the completion of the examinations.

Petitioner shall serve notice of said 1404 examination upon any Guardian ad Litem who shall be appointed within FIVE (5) days of this Order. The SCPA 1404 examination shall not be held without giving the Guardian ad Litem notice to participate therein.

Any discovery demands are to be served within TEN (10) days of this Order and responded to within THIRTY (30) days thereafter.

The failure to conduct 1404 examinations on the above date may be deemed a waiver of the right to file objections or to hold such examinations.

If objections are to be filed, they must be filed within TEN (10) days after completion of such examinations. If objections are not received by the Court in such time the matter will be marked for decree.

Except upon the showing of special circumstances, the examinations will be confined to a three year period prior to the date of the propounded instrument and two years thereafter, or to the date of the decedent's death, whichever is the shorter period.

THE EXAMINATIONS SHALL NOT BE ADJOURNED EXCEPT BY COURT ORDER.
